The Infrared and Raman Users' Group (IRUG) provides a forum for the exchange of infrared (IR) and Raman spectroscopic information, reference spectra and materials. Its biennial conferences offer a unique opportunity to share scientific results and new developments in the application of IR and Raman spectroscopy to the study and conservation of the world's cultural heritage. Conference attendees are typically scientists, conservators, restorers, curators, as well as students within the art conservation and historic preservation fields, who apply IR and Raman spectroscopy to the analysis of art and archeological materials.

IRUG is pleased to announce that the 10th international IRUG conference (IRUG10) will be hosted by the **Department of Analytical Chemistry at the University of Barcelona**, Barcelona, Spain in March 2012. Delegates from universities and museums throughout the world are encouraged to attend to share their experiences in the spectroscopic analysis of cultural heritage materials.

Vibrational spectroscopy for characterization of materials in art and archaeology

Instrumental development on IR and Raman spectroscopy

Non-invasive analysis of works of art and archaeology

Degradation analysis by vibrational spectroscopy

The conference will take place at the **CaixaForum Barcelona** (Av. Francesc Ferrer i Guàrdia, 6-8, 08038 Barcelona - Tel. 93 476 86 00 / Fax: 93 476 86 35).

The building, a former textile factory belonging to the Casaramona family, was commissioned to the famous architect Josep Puig i Cadafalch (1867-1956), who led an important role in the catalan art-nouveau movement known as "modernisme" alongside Gaudí and Domènech i Montaner. Completed in 1911, it was acquired by "la Caixa" in 1963 that restored it to its former glory in 1992. It is now known as CaixaForum providing social, cultural and educational activities.

Abstract Submission

All authors are invited to submit papers covering original work on the topics of IRUG10. Each participant may present up to two abstracts, either as oral or poster presentation. As the number of oral presentations is limited, the Scientific Committee will select them among all the submitted abstracts that have requested oral presentation.

Abstracts should be written in English and contain the purpose of the work, the principal results and the most important conclusions. The text length is limited to 3700 characters.

The abstracts should be submitted by November 15th, 2011. Please send it by e-mail to IRUG10BCN@ub.edu.

The Format of the Abstract

To facilitate the submission and abstracts management, please download the Word form on the IRUG website and fill it out in accordance with these rules:

- Microsoft WORD document;
- ✓ Single space, 3 cm margins;
- ✓ Title in Arial 14 pt bold and centred;
- Leave one empty line and type the names of the authors of the contribution in Arial 12 pt, centred and underlining the author presenting the contribution;
- After another empty line the affiliation of the authors in Arial 11 pt, giving the email address of the author presenting the contribution. If more than one affiliation is included, please differentiate them by index numbers;
- The text body of the abstract (in Arial 12 pt) starts following one empty line after the affiliation block;
- ✓ References at the end of the abstract;
- ✓ Illustrations will be reproduced in black and white in the Book of Abstracts.





Information for Presentations

The language of the conference is English. Oral communications will last 20 minutes and include a discussion of 5 minutes.

The poster boards should have dimensions of 100 cm height by 90 cm width. Mounting supplies for posters will be provided by the Organizing Committee.
