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### WORKSHOP ON: *Leadership in Academic Medicine*

This workshop is intended for current and potential future deans of medical schools. Workshop participants will examine their own abilities and leadership style; will discuss and study the issues in leading the medical school team; will undertake practical exercises in combining both the resolution of day-to-day problems and the development and implementation of long-term strategy.

The workshop follows the highly successful workshops at the AMSE meetings in Turku (2005) on medical university administration, and in Lisbon (2007) on performance management in the administration of medical and health sciences university institutions.
