WORKSHOP ON: *European Specifications of the WFME Global Standards for Quality Improvement in Medical Education.*

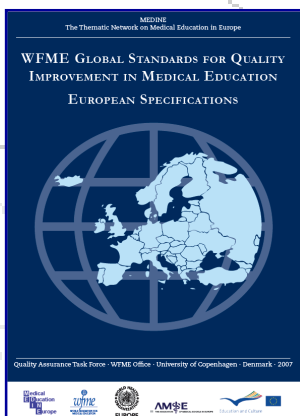
WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES: Validation, dissemination and implementation of these standards

The workshop will start briefly reporting the process to develop the European Specifications of the WFME Global Standards for Quality Improvement in Medical Education and experiences from implementing Standards in Medical Education. This will be followed by small group discussion on the methodological aspects and experiences from implementing Standards at all levels of medical education: basic, postgraduate and continuing medical education. Finally, main conclusions and recommendations will be identified and summarized. Outcomes of the workshop will be presented to AMSE 2008 Annual Conference followed by further discussion (June 6, afternoon session).
