- Brief scientific and ethics justification of the research project which includes a description of the impact expected in the participant persons and affected collectives, and generally about the benefits and risks foreseen as a result of the research.
- Description of the methodology and techniques used.
- Detailed information on what the volunteer or the collective participant in the research will receive.

In the cases when it is foreseen to request the participation of minors considered as such by law in research projects or PhD projects, additionally to the signature of the parents or the legally responsible of the minors, at the informed consent form it will be needed to state explicitly the agreement of the children and that they have been previously informed, attending to gradual standards in their capacity of understanding the characteristics and aim of the project.

- You must add the document model project information and the consent document that will be used, as well as the procedure used to obtain it.

On data protection:

Attended what establishes the Regulation 2016/679 of the European Union, of 27th April, relative to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of his personal data and the Organic Law 3/2018, of 5 December, of protection of personal data and guarantee of digital rights, in the case that in the realization of the project of research or the PhD thesis personal data are obtained -included biometric data, genetic and any other of personal character and with special care when it comes to children-, it is necessary to feature explicitly who is the manager of the treatment and

custody of the data collected, as well as in which device will store and/or process and of which type of this treats : if they are encoded, pseudonimized or anonimized.

In addition, both senior researchers and PhD students will have to add the following paragraphs to the sheets of information to the voluntary participants and to the sheets of consent:

a) In compliance with the established to the mentioned regulation, the UNIVERSITY OF BARCELONA, (with CIF Q0818001J and domicile to Gran Via de les Corts Catalanes, 585 -08007 Barcelona) as a manager of the treatment of the personal data, informs that it can contact with the Delegate of Protection of Data by means of writing to the postal address (Travessera de les Corts, 131-159, Pavelló Rosa, 08028 - Barcelona), or by means of a message of e-mail to protecciodedades@ub.edu.

b) You have the right to access to your data, request the rectification of the inaccurate data or, if that's the case, request the elimination, as well as limit the treatment, oppose and withdraw the consent of their use for determinate purposes. These rights can be executed by means of writing to the postal address or by means of an email to the address mentioned in the previous paragraph. Likewise, we inform you of your right to present a claim in front of the Catalan Agency of Protection of Data in the case of any performance of the University of Barcelona that you consider to violate your rights.

In the case of projects of research and theses of PhD based in surveys, questionnaires and alike, in order to fulfil with the normative of protection of data and guarantee the privacy of the voluntary participants in the research and of his personal data, suits to use the program FORMS available in the UB-cloud (<https://www.ub.edu/portal/web/iub/nuvol-ub>).

In all cases, you shall add:

- Commitment, signed by the main project investigator and / or the director of the doctoral Thesis that confidentiality of given personal data that can be obtained in the project will be scrupulously respected, both concerning its academic use and its public dissemination. If you consider that any outcome of the project may affect or be of interest to individuals or participant groups you must notify.

- Commitment not to use personal data obtained for other different studies. In the latter case, researchers must apply for a Commission report before doing so.
- Commitment that you will not commit any type of plagiarism in the contents of the present thesis of doctorate, TFG or TFM, for part of the members that can take part, according to what the Codes of Good Practical in research say.
- Commitment of the principal investigator or project director of the doctoral Thesis to consider the Commission's Statements about the participation of students in research projects (*only when appropriate*) and about possible ethical problems in the scientific publications and about the information sheet delivered to the participants in the project. - You must specify the financial compensation or other provided in the Project, both for the principal investigator (or for the research team) and for participating individuals or groups. If it is not expected to provide it, it should be stated on this way.
- Specifying the subscribed insurance coverage on behalf of the participating volunteers, if applicable.
- Other important information given.
