## “FRANCISCO TOMÁS Y VALIENTE” IX AWARDS CALL

The Interuniversity Association of Law Students (AINED), in collaboration with the Department of Criminal Law and Criminal Sciences from the University of Barcelona, with the aim to stimulate scientific research in the field of criminal law and criminal science, announces the "Francisco Tomás y Valiente" IX Awards, for the year 2012.

Category A is directed to the projects submitted by Ph. D. candidates and category B to undergraduate students of law, Criminology and Legal or Social science.

### TERMS

#### Prizes

**I.-** Category-A winner (Ph. D. candidates) will be awarded with a prize of 300 euros and bibliography materials.

Category-B winner (undergraduates) will be awarded with a prize of 200 euros and bibliography materials.

Each prize will be awarded to just one submitted project. The prizes will not be split.

The organization, according to the term VIII, and in response to the content and quality of the projects, reserves the right to declare the award empty.

#### Participants

**II.-** Individuals Students enrolled in the XIX Congress of Students on Criminal Sciences 2012 (“**Corruption ↔ Crisis of values**”), March 21, 22 and 23, 2012, at the University of Barcelona) are allowed to apply for this award. Prize A is addressed to Graduates students in Law, Criminology or another legal or social science, by a University school or any higher educational institution legally recognized, public or private, national or international, without a Ph. D. Prize B is addressed to undergraduate students in Law, Criminology or any Legal or Social science, by a university school or other higher education institution legally recognized, either public or private, national or international.



## Submission requirements

**III.-** The Projects may address some of the issues included in the XIX Congress of Criminal Sciences Students 2012, which are the following:

- ⤴ Sociological, economic, political and organizational aspects of corruption
- ⤴ Principals and accomplices
- ⤴ The liability of legal entities and other entities
- ⤴ Liability of public oversight bodies
- ⤴ Liability of internal monitoring bodies of companies
- ⤴ Liability of public internal monitoring bodies
- ⤴ Criminal intent
- ⤴ The administrativation of the Criminal law
- ⤴ International approach of corruption
- ⤴ Preventing strategies, punishments and measures
- ⤴ Rehabilitation of the corrupt and corrupter
- ⤴ Public corruption
- ⤴ Political corruption
- ⤴ Urban planning corruption
- ⤴ Private corruption
- ⤴ *Mass media* and corruption

**IV.-** A hard-copy of the project can be submitted in person or sent to the Department of Criminal Law and Criminal Sciences from the University of Barcelona (Avda. Diagonal 684, 08034 Barcelona), and must fulfil the following requirements:

- 1 The projects should be original and unpublished, written in Spanish, Catalan or English. Consequently, the projects presented in competition may not have been published before the celebration of the XIX Congress of Students.
- 2 Proposals are to be typewritten on A4-size white paper, double spaced, and on one side only. Proposals should be saved as Microsoft Word file onto a CD, and the electronic copy included in the application package.
- 3 The projects should have a minim length of 20 pages and a maximum of 50, including its relevant bibliography.
- 4 Authors may use a pseudonym. To ensure the objectivity, the author's true name should not appear on the project. A sealed envelope with the pseudonym and the title of the project written on it should be presented. The full name, academic titles, identity card or passport number, address and contact numbers of the author should be enclosed.
- 5 Each submission should include, along with the project, an abstract (three sheets or less) to be used as a communication, following the Term VII.



## **Deadline**

**V.-** The submission deadline: March 15, 2012, at 2.00 pm.

## **Jury and Judgement**

**VI.-** The jury will be formed by the professors participating in the Congress.

**VII.-** The jury will select from the submitted projects, those that in their opinion possess higher quality. The elected projects will be defended by their respective authors during the development of the XIX Congress of Criminal Sciences Students, at the time the organization deemed appropriate and adjusting to the submitted abstract.

**VIII.-** The jury can declare an award empty if the projects do not obey the established basis or do not gather enough merits.

**IX.-** The Final Decision will be announced during the celebration of the Closure Ceremony of the Congress, on Friday, March 23th, 2012, at 12.30pm.

**X.-** The originals not awarded may be removed from the Department of Criminal Law and Criminal Sciences at the University of Barcelona, within thirty days of the date of the jury's verdict. After this period, the AINED is not responsible for its loss or destruction.
