

PhD on Risk-based Selection of Flood Inundation Models, University of Leeds

Applications are sought for this PhD position as part of the University of Leeds' work within the Flood Risk Management Research Consortium (FRMRC: www.floodrisk.org.uk). The work will be supervised by Professor Nigel Wright at Leeds and Professor Paul Bates at the University of Bristol as part of the consortium which includes a large number of UK universities and research organisations.

There will be opportunity for the student to work with commercial partners in the UK and academic collaborators in the USA, the Netherlands and elsewhere. The student will have access to high-performance computing facilities at the University of Leeds.

Students should have a degree that demonstrates numeracy and/or a physical understanding of the natural environment. The nature of the funding means that only UK or EU residents are eligible for support.
