

The LOGOS Research Group wishes to inform young researchers in philosophy at the postdoctoral stages of their careers of the recent publication of 3 calls:

(1) The Spanish ministry for research and education, the Ministerio de Economía y Competitividad, has just published a call for a number of 2-year postdoctoral Juan de la Cierva fellowships, for which only those candidates are eligible who have obtained their PhD between 01/01/2013 and 31/12/2014 (for candidates with at least 50% disability this period is extended to 01/01/2012). The period of application will begin 13/01/2015 and end 03/02/2015. Applications by eligible candidates must be included in a matching application to be submitted by some member of a Spanish department or research centre willing to incorporate the successful applicant. (2) The same ministry has also published a call for a number of 2-year postdoctoral Juan de la Cierva fellowships, for which only those candidates are eligible who have already had some postdoctoral training and obtained their PhD between 01/01/2010 and 31/12/2012 (for candidates with at least 50% disability this period is extended to 01/01/2008). The period of application will begin 08/01/2015 and end 29/01/2015. Again, applications by eligible candidates must be included in a matching application to be submitted by some member of a Spanish department or research centre willing to incorporate the successful applicant. (3) The Catalan government, through its research agency AGAUR, has just issued a call for a number of 2-year postdoctoral Beatriu de Pinós fellowships. The period of application begins 12/12/2014 and ends 05/02/2015. Applications must ultimately be presented by researchers from a Catalan institution who sponsor the relevant candidate. See:

Please note (i) that the LOGOS Research Group itself is neither the grant-awarding body nor a department or a research centre, nor is it the only group based at a Spanish institution that might incorporate successful applicants; (ii) that support from members of the group is not automatic but subject to their explicit agreement in the light of the candidate's academic profile, and (iii) that since the fellowships under (1) and (2) require co-financing by the relevant university, support of Juan de la Cierva applications is ultimately conditional on securing the signature of the head of department.
