

The LOGOS Research Group wishes to inform young researchers in philosophy at the postdoctoral stages of their careers that the Spanish ministry for research and education, the Ministerio de Economía y Competitividad (MINECO), has recently published two distinct calls for a number of postdoctoral fellowships.

- (1) The first call, for ‘**Ayudas Juan de la Cierva-formación**’, is addressed to early stage researchers who were **awarded their PhD between 1 January 2018 and 31 December 2019**. The period of application will begin on **18 December 2019 and will end on 15 January 2020**. Applications by eligible candidates must be included in a matching application to be submitted by a member of a department or research centre within Spain, willing to incorporate the successful applicant. - (2) The second call, for ‘**Ayudas Juan de la Cierva incorporación**’, is addressed to researchers who were **awarded their PhD between 1 January 2015 and 31 December 2017**. The period of application will begin on **17 December 2019 and will end on 15 January 2020**. Applications by eligible candidates must be included in a matching application to be submitted by a member of a department or research centre within Spain, willing to incorporate the successful applicant.
