Since it was founded in 1450, the University of Barcelona has worked tirelessly in the pursuit of academic and research excellence, and today it is looked to as a national and international leader in education, science and knowledge.

This status is reflected in the UB's position in the most prestigious European and international rankings: it is the only Spanish member of the League of European Research Universities and is the most innovative university in Spain according to the Reuters Top 100: The World's Most Innovative Universities, in which it is placed 75th worldwide. The 2019 edition of the Europe Teaching Rankings included in Times Higher Education placed the University of Barcelona 29th in Europe, and it continues to be among the top 200 universities in the world, according to the Academic Ranking of World Universities, the OS World University Rankings and the Clarivate Analytics Round University Ranking.

This academic year will unquestionably be defined by the COVID-19 pandemic, which forced the abrupt and unprecedented closure of the University and has obliged us to move practically all aspects of our work online. Nevertheless, thanks to the efforts of the entire university community we have been able to bring the year to a satisfactory close.

Over the last few months the University has again demonstrated its value to society, making decisive contributions to research and innovation initiatives targeting COVID-19. The UB's teaching staff have continued to work with the media, lending expertise and academic rigour to information on the pandemic and its impact across different settings. At this time of crisis, the University of Barcelona stands

firm in meeting its responsibilities to all sectors of society and will continue in its endeavours, despite the complexities of our new reality.

On the pages that follow, then, you will find the figures that reflect the most noteworthy academic, research, transfer and internationalization activities carried out over the course of the academic year 2019-2020, together with key data pertaining to UB structures, activities and services.



The UB's actions and collaborative initiatives with the Catalan Ministry of Health in the context of the COVID-19 health crisis include the transfer of 6 mechanical ventilators and 1 defibrillator, the donation of 33,874 face masks, 5,385 litres of disinfectant and other healthcare materials, the production of 1,086 3D-printed protective visors and the development of 3 new models of emergency respirator.

For the **academic year 2020-2021**, 17,548 students have chosen the UB as their **first option**. This figure represents 31% of first-choice applications in the Catalan public university system. With 10,913 places offered, this puts the **demand ratio for places** at the UB at 1.6.








