The University of Barcelona (UB) is a benchmark institution for teaching, scientific inquiry and knowledge creation in Spain and abroad, and its academic and research activities are grounded in the concepts of quality and innovation. The UB's commitment to good governance and ethical conduct has been reinforced this year with the approval of a code of conduct for managers and senior managers at the institution and with the rollout of the ethics mailbox on institutional integrity.

The UB's expansive academic offering, which covers all branches of knowledge, attracts more than 60,000 students a year. In the area of research, the UB continues to post excellent results, including more than 190 million euros in research funding secured and a total of 7,876 scientific publications.

The UB's leadership is recognized by a host of external institutions: it ranks as one of the top 200 universities in the world according to the most influential international rankings and, since 2010, it is the only university in Spain that is a member of the prestigious League of European Research Institutions (LERU). The UB's leadership is also reflected in the expansion of the CHARM-EU strategic alliance, which is headed by the UB.

The UB, in accordance with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and Agenda 2030, is firmly committed to sustainability, understood in the broadest sense. Indeed, the UB's commitment drives action, for example by engaging in ecologically responsible conduct and by showing respect for different gender identities through the creation of appropriate instruments, such as a new protocol for preventing, detecting and taking action on situations of sexual harassment or harassment on

the grounds of sex, gender identity or sexual orientation, or any other sexist or anti-LGBTQIA+ conduct.

Founded in 1450, the UB is delighted to celebrate the sesquicentenary of its iconic Historic Building in the academic year 2022-2023. Designed by the architect Elies Rogent, the Historic Building marked the decisive return of the UB to the city of Barcelona, where it now stands as a major symbol of the Catalan capital.

On the pages that follow, you will find figures that reflect the most noteworthy academic, research, transfer and internationalization activities carried out over the course of the academic year 2021-2022, together with key data on UB structures, activities and services.



• • For the academic year 2022-2023, 18,802 students have chosen the UB as their first option. This figure represents 32.7% of first-choice applications in the Catalan public university system. With 10,960 places offered, this puts the demand ratio for places at the UB at 1.7.






