The University of Barcelona

Since it was founded in the year 1450, the University of Barcelona has been a leading centre of education, science and critical thought. The quality of its teaching and research, which have won recognition both within and outside Spain, complements the University's commitment to serving the interests of local society and the country as a whole, and combines with a demonstrably dynamic, constructive and humanist character that permeates the daily activities of the institution.

Demand for courses at the UB is now 1.4 times greater than the number of places on offer, and the University's six campuses are home to over 80,000 students each year, distributed across 66 bachelor's degrees, more than 140 university master's degrees, 71 doctoral programmes, over 300 postgraduate courses and some 400 on-site and distance lifelong learning courses. A broad selection of courses is offered, covering the many disciplines that make up the principal branches of knowledge: humanities, health sciences, social and legal sciences, and experimental sciences and engineering.

The University of Barcelona has two campuses of international excellence — the BKC Knowledge Campus and the HUBc Health Sciences campus — that have bolstered institutional policies on intensive research, knowledge transfer to wider society and internationalization. This year, the UB also hosted the first Arab-Euro Conference on Higher Education (AECHE), which drew the participation of more than 150 universities from 40 countries. This academic year saw the creation of the new Doctoral School, which oversees the doctoral programmes offered by the UB. Important work was also carried out by the Committee for the Reform of the UB Statute, and the supplementary financial aid programme for students was put into operation.

Solidarity, international development cooperation, volunteering with institutions such as the Red Cross and the Banc d'Aliments food bank foundation, good practices in environmental management, sustainability and social responsibility are among the primary concerns that were addressed by the activities of the University community throughout the academic year 2012-2013.

The figures presented here summarize the UB's actions and activities over the last academic year in the areas of teaching, research, innovation, internationalization and mobility.












