In the context of the implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the SDGs, the sustainability of the planet has one of its main challenges in marine spaces. Global warming implies irreversible changes and transformations in their morphology; many of the human activities that take place in these spaces contribute to this warming and increase the degradation of the marine environment. At the same time, the seas and oceans constitute a new opportunity for the development of renewable energies whose installation causes contradictions with the legitimate interests of coastal populations. The joint treatment of this reality is unavoidable, both from the international and European perspective and from the specific perspective of a city like Barcelona, where the different dimensions of the identified problems converge for different reasons.

The Congress **aims** to address from an academic perspective the challenges posed by the demands of sustainability on the main uses of maritime spaces and, therefore, the transformations and impact that these demands impose in economic, social, regulatory and environmental terms, also for the local communities particularly affected.
