GUIDELINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF FINAL PAPERS

Languages: Papers may be presented in Catalan, Spanish, French, Portuguese or English. We recommend that the oral presentation is done in Spanish, but it can also be presented in any of the languages mentioned above. Please, keep in mind that there will be no simultaneous translation.

Length: The maximum length will be 3000 words, including notes and bibliography. Format: WORD. Maximum 8 Mb.

Main text: Font Times New Roman (TNR) 12 pt. Text should be justified. Line spacing: 1.5. Margins (right and left, top and bottom): 2.5 cm. Do not use indentation at the beginning of a paragraph and do not use font styles (italic, bold, underlined, uppercase) to indicate emphasis.

Footnotes: TNR 10 pt, numbered, justified, single line spacing. Footnotes should be aclaratory. Do not use them to insert bibliographic references.

Page numbering: Lower center margin, without format or emphasis.

Paper title: TNR 16 pt., bold capital letters, centered.

Author(s), email and affiliation: TNR 14pt., right alignment. No font styles.

Sections (1,2,3 ...) and subsections titles (1.1,1.2 ...): TNR 14pt., lowercase, bold. Always leave a line between the end of a section and the following section title, and between the section title and the following text.

Quotes in the text will have no font style and will appear between quotation marks. Authors' quotes or fieldwork excerpts that you wish to add as an independent paragraph will be indented 1 cm to the left, in the same font size and single line spacing.

Images: Inserted or embedded in the document (neither linked nor pasted), preferably in a standard format (jpg, gif) and, if possible, an image resolution of 600dpi. Always indicate the source or authorship. The same rules apply for the tables.

Bibliographic references in the text, both in footnotes or after quotes: Lévi-Strauss (1986:202).

Bibliography: Bibliography will be at the end of the document in alphabetical order. Please, use the Harvard system. References must be quoted in the text by author and year of publication. The logic is as follows: who (author) - when (year) - what (original title) - where (depending on the reference: book - place and the publisher-, journal -volume, number, pages, website address if any-). If the author is unknown, the reference will be ordered according to the first letter of the title.

Example (books):

Example (book chapters):

Beck-Gernsheim, E. (2001) "Mujeres migrantes, trabajo doméstico y matrimonio. Las mujeres en un mundo en proceso de globalización". In Beck-Gernsheim, E., Butler, J. and Puigbert, L. Mujeres y transformaciones sociales. Barcelona: El Roure.

GUIDELINES FOR POSTERS

The poster must not be bigger than 90 cm (wide) and 120 cm (high). Letter size should allow comfortable reading at approximately 1.5 meters.

Deadline for texts submission: March 30th, 2019.
