

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CONSULTATION AND REPRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS FROM THE GENERAL AND HISTORICAL ARCHIVE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF BARCELONA (AGHUB)

The AGHUB is currently reorganizing its collection to improve the service offered to researchers at the UB.

While the improvements are being carried out, all researchers are kindly asked to follow the instructions below prior to sending requests for the consultation or reproduction of documents.

Consultation

- Unless Express authorisation is given, all documents must be consulted at the AGHUB. Please bear in mind that we are only able to attend users on Thursdays (excluding public holidays) between 9 am and 2 pm. We will notify users of those Thursdays during Easter Week, Christmas, and the months of July and August on which the office will be closed for staff holidays.
- Notify us of the request by e-mail prior to your visit, which will enable us to prepare the documentation required.
- Do not come to the AGHUB until you have received confirmation that your request has been arranged, as the space available to researchers is limited.
- When requesting documentation related to personal records, please specify BOTH surnames (where applicable) and the first name if possible.
- Pending system updates, the locations of documentation not included in personal records can only be retrieved manually. We regret that we are unable to perform this service for you.
- You may consult a maximum of 10 separate documents or sheaves of documents in one day.
- Consultation of personal records is restricted by privacy and data protection legislation, according to which the information may only be accessed after a period of 25 years following the death of the individual concerned. If this period has not elapsed or the individual is alive, you must obtain express authorisation from a direct family member and submit this to the AGHUB together with a copy of his/her official identity document.

Reproduction

- Complete the on-line reproduction request with your details and the type of work for which the research is being carried out (publication, academic study, exhibition, etc.)
- You should also include the area of study to which the research is related, as this will help us to compile comprehensive statistics and improve our service.
- You may reproduce up to 10 sheets of DIN A3 or DIN A4.
- Requested reproductions will be provided within 30 days with the exception of some digital reproductions, which may take longer to prepare. The AGHUB will contact you by telephone or e-mail to arrange collection and payment.
- For digital reproductions, please specify the desired format (TIFF or JPEG). TIFF files will be provided on a CD as they are too large to be sent by e-mail.
- Until further notice, all reproduced documents should be collected from and paid for in cash at the Reserve Library, from Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 8 pm. Information on rates is available at:

- In exceptional circumstances, reproductions may be sent by certified post. Payment must cover postage costs and should be made by postal order.
- If you intend to use the reproduced material for publication or public presentation, you must cite the reference given in the authorisation received from the AGHUB.
- The AGHUB shall not be held liable for any use that the researcher may make of the reproduced documentation outside the standard terms of the authorisation.
