Disabilities

Accommodation

You're guaranteed a place in university accommodation if you apply before the deadline. Living options are available in Oadby Student Village (OSV) or City Living. The OSV is approximately a 40 minute walk from the main campus, and there is a regular bus to and from campus. Set in the beautiful surrounding of our botanical gardens, OSV is ideal for student living with a Village Hub and a supermarket nearby. City Living halls are approximately a 10 minute walk from the main campus. For information on university accommodation at Leicester please see: <http://www2.le.ac.uk/offices/accommodation>. Popular halls among exchange students for City Living options include Nixon Court and Opal Court.

Students must apply for accommodation before the deadline to be considered (1st September for Semester 1, and 1st December for Semester 2). A deposit of £250 is required to secure the booking. Applications can be made through the accommodation portal: https://rooms.le.ac.uk/student_portal/. We cannot guarantee that students will be allocated their preferred choice.

Costs

Surveys by NatWest Student Living Index 2018 have found that the University of Leicester is the 3rd most affordable city for undergraduate students in the UK.
