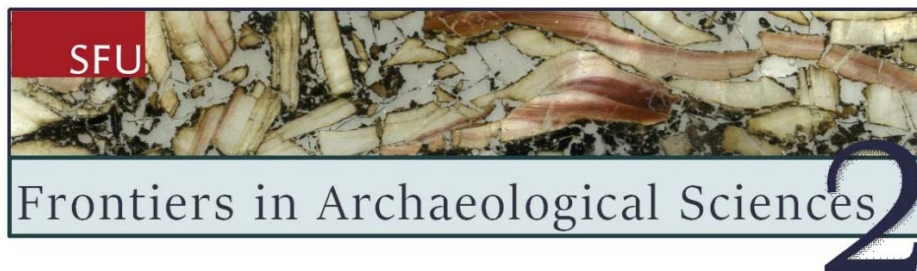

### **Registration, Podium and Poster Presentations Submission**

Pre-registration for general attendees and submission for 16 podium and 25 poster presentations is still open using the downloadable pre-registration form. The pre-registration deadline is April 30<sup>th</sup> 2018. We encourage registration and submissions from junior researchers and underrepresented groups. Podium presentations will be 20 minutes in length followed by a 10-minute Q & A period.

### **Abstract Submission Instructions**

A 150-word abstract and name(s) and affiliation(s) of coauthor(s) can be submitted using the downloadable pre-registration form. Submissions will be reviewed by the **scientific committee** and contributions will be accepted based on originality, scientific merit, and best integration with the whole submission pool. On May 8<sup>th</sup> 2018, applicants will receive an email confirming acceptance with assigned session for oral or poster presentation and instructions on how to register.

### **Registration**

All participants (presenters and general attendees) must register for the conference following the instructions that will be notified on May 8<sup>th</sup> 2018.
