

GRADE DISTRIBUTION:

To ensure transparent and coherent information on the performance of the individual student, the Universitat de Barcelona provides the following information about its grading scale, following the national legislation and the statistical distribution table (ECTS grade) following the "ECTS Users' Guide".

1.- National grading system:

Grades are regulated by Royal Decree 1125/2003, 5 September, and are awarded according to the following numerical scale from 0 to 10.

2.- ECTS grade system:

The Universitat de Barcelona's ECTS grading scale describes individual student performance in relation to the cohort as a whole, using the results of the two previous academic years. In this scale, the students who pass a subject are divided in five groups:

The top 10% are awarded the grade A, the following 25%, the grade B, the following 30%, the grade C; the following 25%, the grade D, and the lowest 10%, the grade E. When student's grade cannot be quantified, this is indicated by the abbreviation "NQ".
