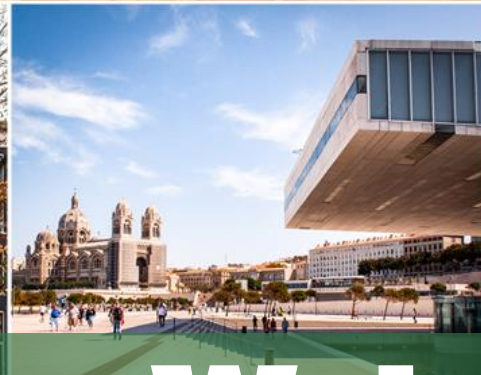

Requisities

- 
- ✓ **Have a valid DNI or NIE.**
 - ✓ **Have at least 30 ECTS of an official MSc Degree program enrolled at the moment of the application and prove you have passed them before the exchange.**

Requisites

✓ **Be a UB student next academic year 2022-23 in the degree for which the application has been submitted. This is: formalize your enrolment in the MSc next academic year according to the indications given and before your exchange.**

International Mobility Programs

Requisities



- ✓ **A student going on exchange is a full-time student and so, in the case of master students, they must do at the foreign institution, and have recognized at the UB, between 24 - 30 ECTS for one-semester exchanges (20 ECTS for students in MSc programs functioning with 3 months terms).**



- ❖ **Exchange students do not have to pay tuition fees at the foreign institution. They may be required to pay small fees for other purposes (material, student unions, etc.).**
- ❖ **Selected students will be responsible for all the costs related to the mobility (accommodation, travel, etc.).**



- ❖ **Within the Erasmus+ program, the UB provides selected students with an accidents and repatriation insurance covering the whole exchange period of the Erasmus+ studies. Students are however also responsible for having a valid health insurance covering the entire exchange period.**



- ❖ **Under the Global Faculty program, students are required to take out medical, accident and repatriation insurance with coverage for the duration of their stay.**
- ❖ **Being selected by the UB does not automatically imply that the student is also accepted by the foreign institution.**

By clicking on the + icon you will have access to a lot of information of each destination (position in international rankings, language requirements, course offer, iro webpage & contact, etc).

Toulouse and Kyoto have specific language requirements. Make sure you meet the language requirements before applying for these destinations:

Toulouse: It is necessary to submit one of the following certificates when doing the application: BULATS English (Business Language Testing Service) 60; CAMBRIDGE FCE, CAE, CPE; IELTS (Academic module) overall 6; TOEFL iBT 79 or TOEIC 785 (TOEFL ITP is not accepted). It also will be possible to certify the level of English with the enrolment to the MSc in English, in case the Bachelor Degree has also been done entirely in English.

Kyoto: Certificate according to the Language Accreditation Procedure of the UB with a minimum level of C1 or IELTS 6.5/TOEFL iBT: 93. Certificates shall not be issued later than 2 years.

For all the other destinations, it won't be necessary to certify the level of English when doing the application. The level of language is certified by being enrolled in a MSc entirely taught in English.

However, we strongly recommend to have & submit a valid certificate according to the “Language Accreditation Procedure” of the UB in order to apply for supplementary grants.

International Mobility Programs

Language requirements

- a) The presentation of the copy of the official certificate, as long as it is included in the CIC Document or the ACLES List.
- b) The presentation of the copy of the enrollment (academic year 2021 - 2022) of the School of Modern Languages of the UB, which will accredit the *previous* level of language.
- c) In the case of another document that is not listed in section A or B, it will be possible to consult with the coordinators of the EIM of the UB. The EIM will accredit the student's language skills directly to the study center (without issuing a certificate).
- d) In the case of not having any document included of those included in sections A, B or C, the language skills can be accredited by taking the language exams organized by the EIM of the UB, under the indications and deadlines indicated at: EIM LEVEL TESTS FOR INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY PROGRAMS. The EIM will accredit the student's language skills directly to the study center and will also issue an accreditation with the student's level of language proficiency. Registration to tests is now open and is done online through the link provided.

The application is done online in the UB platform: Mobility Online – SOP

You have to chose :

- ✓ **Programa d'intercanvi: Erasmus+ Estudis or Global Faculty**
- ✓ **Facultat: Facultat d'Economia i Empresa**
- ✓ **Ensenyament: Your MSc Degree**
- ✓ **Curs: 2022-23**

To start your application process you have to click on the green button of your preferred university (first choice). You will be able then to add more universities -up to 5.

Once you have finished the application, you must submit it through the same platform, with the other documents, if applicable.

If more than one application is submitted, only the last one will be considered valid.

All the destinations in Europe belong to the program Erasmus+ Estudis (Erasmus+ Studies). You can do one application and choose 5 destinations, prioritizing them.

Kyoto belongs to the program Global Faculty.

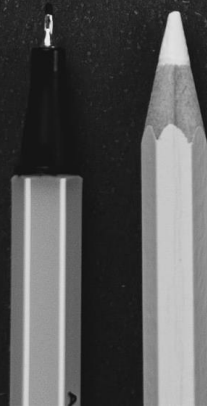
In case you want to apply for both programs, you must submit two applications, one for each program.

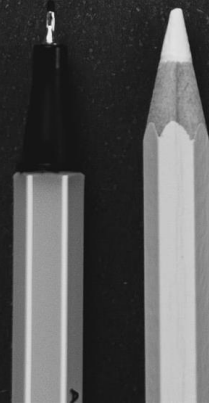
Documentation

***It is only necessary to certify the language level, according to the requirements, for Toulouse and Kyoto. For all the other universities it is not necessary to present a language certificate when doing the application. The level of language is certified by being enrolled in a MSc entirely taught in English.**

However, we recommend to have & submit a valid certificate according to the “Language Accreditation Procedure” of the UB in order to apply for the supplementary grants.

“Language Accreditation Procedure”:

- ✓ **Any certificate included in the following documents: ACLES o CIC**
- ✓ **Current enrolment of an EIM course**
 - ✓ **EIM exam**



If you have any problem when submitting your application in the SOP platform:

Selected students who have received a general scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport or a scholarship from the Department of Education of the Basque Country in the 2021-2022 academic year, those who have a recognized disability legally qualified to a degree equal to or greater than 33% or those who prove to have the status of refugee or have the right to subsidiary protection or who have applied for international protection in Spain:

Selected students with a recognized and legally qualified disability of 33% or more may apply for the SEPIE call for grants to cover the extraordinary expenses caused by mobility.

Green Travel: single payment of 50€ per sustainable trip to the destination and, if applicable, up to 4 additional scholarship days.

Grant of € 200 per month, up to 6 months

SANTANDER-UB

Sole payment of 200€ in the framework of the Erasmus+ program

Sole payment of 1000€ in the framework of the Global Faculty program

Other grants

SANTANDER-ERASMUS

Only for the Erasmus+ Program

2 grants consisting in a single payment of 2,000€ (for students with a recognized disability of more than 33%) and 49 grants consisting in a single payment of 500€.
