Accommodation

Regarding the accommodation options available in Barcelona, you can consult the following <u>link</u>. The UB works with <u>Barcelona Centre Universitari (BCU)</u>, which cooperates with most of the Catalan universities. BCU is a tool of the Government of Catalonia, the Barcelona City Council and the universities. BCU provides students with various accommodation options. Their accommodation service is called "<u>Your Student Housing</u>" and is oriented towards temporary students.

Also, we would like to remind you that it is important to use the official resources regarding accommodation to avoid potential scams. Note that, in case anything happens, we can only intervene in case the accommodation has been booked through these official providers.

Courses and course registration

The registration of courses has already been done. If you have had any problem, there will be a modification period in September, open also to those students who missed the registration of courses period. Be aware that some courses are already full and that you will have to have some alternatives for each of your preferred courses.
