



RIGHT TO INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Purpose of data processing	Managing the "2026 IN2UB Annual Inhouse Meeting". Your participation in the congress includes sending you information related to the annual meeting (through the email provided) and the dissemination of the information you provide us (the abstract and your identifying, academic and professional data) within the framework of the congress, in the posters published or to generate the book of abstracts (which can be published in IN2UB website) and other material related to the event. The Poster Author email provided in this form will be the one published in the book of abstracts.
Lawful basis	The lawful basis for the collection of personal data is the performance of a task carried out in the public interest (Organic Law 2/2023, of 22 March, on Universities, and Law 1/2003, of 19 February, on Catalan Universities).
Period of data storage	Data will be stored during the period required to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected and to determine any possible responsibilities deriving therefrom.
Recipients	The recipients are the University itself and the designated data processors, where applicable. Data will not be disclosed to third parties unless there is a legal obligation to do so.
Data subject rights	You may exercise your rights of access, rectification, objection, erasure, restriction of processing, and portability at any time by submitting a written request to the General Secretary's Office of the University of Barcelona, by post (Gran Via de les Corts Catalanes, 585, 08007 Barcelona) or by email (secretaria.general@ub.edu). You will need to attach a photocopy of your Spanish identity document (DNI/NIE) or other valid form of ID.
Data protection officer	If you consider that your rights have not been given due consideration, you can contact the UB Data Protection Officer by post (Gran Via de les Corts Catalanes, 585, 08007 Barcelona) or email (protecciodedades@ub.edu).
Supervisory authority	You may also file a complaint with the Catalan Data Protection Authority.
