

More Additional Fragments of the Instructions of Šuruppak

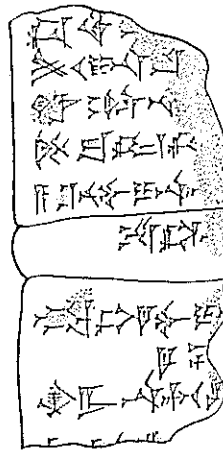


Fig. 1. 3N-T 123

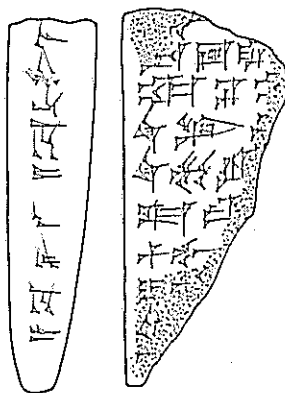


Fig. 2. A 33687
