Fol. 61^v (in red): 'Scripta sunt hec per Stephanum lannkchamer de Patauia [Passau] Clericum eiusdem diocesis Anno M^o cccc^o liiij In die Sanctissimi principis apostolorum beati Petri ad Vincula In opido Praunaw [Braunau] duce ludwico regnante per Bauoariam [Ludwig IX, 1450-79]'. Part of a compilation of Lull's works written by Stephen and by another, unnamed, scribe working in collaboration; thus fols 291-315, containing 'Aliqua puncta artis generalis', was begun by Stephen and concluded by the second hand. Elsewhere (fols 187-206, a gloss on the *Ars generalis*) Stephen corrected the second scribe's work; and in fols 231-290, 'Disputatio quinque sapientum', written by the second scribe, Stephen provided the rubrics. Fols 1-10, 72-119, 207-30 are by Stephen alone, the second scribe writing fols 131-86 and 187-206. Fols 62-71 and 120-30 are blank.

Fol. 69: 'Explicit generalis tabula artis generalis magistri Raymundi Lullij de cathelonia scripta Anno domini 1467 et finita die 4 octobris pyr' [?] Laudetur Jesus cristus amen'; fol. 69^v blank. The scribe resumed copying on fol. 70 (end quire 7) with 'breuis et utilis declaratio artis generalis' and completed it on fol. 97. Fol. 98^{r-v} blank. Fols 1-10 (quire 1) contain an imperfect epitome of 'De auditu Kabbalistico' and some diagrams.
