Dear colleagues

We inform you that the call for communications is open for its presentation in the thematic sessions of the II International Symposium on Religious Mystics and Heterodoxies, which will take place on January 31 and February 1 and 2, 2024, at the Faculty of Geography and History of the University of Barcelona (Campus Raval). The Symposium is organized by the GREMHER research group and the University of Barcelona, with the support of the Pluralism and Coexistence Foundation in its 2021 call for grants to carry out activities aimed at promoting knowledge and accommodation of religious diversity in a framework for dialogue, promotion of coexistence and the fight against intolerance and hate speech.

The communications will be attached to one of the thematic sessions of the symposium. You can find on our website the different sessions in which you can present your proposal: <https://www.ub.edu/plurirelig/sesiones-tematicas/>

The symposium will be in a hybrid format. We request that you inform us if you plan to present your communication in person or virtually. However, in order to favor the academic meeting, the organizing committee encourages the participants in the event to, as far as possible, share their contributions in person.

Communications proposal

Proposals must include:

a) Title of the communication.

b) Brief summary of a minimum of 175 and a maximum of 250 words.

c) Name, surname, affiliation and email address of the author or authors.

Proposals will have to indicate which thematic session they consider appropriate to join and in what modality they will be held (in person or virtual). No more than two communications per person may be presented in the symposium as a whole.

You are strongly requested to take care of the style, spelling, writing, technical vocabulary and content of the abstracts of the communications and follow the established length guidelines. The abstracts will be evaluated for their admission and those accepted will appear in the Symposium Program. After the closing of the symposium, the summaries of the communications presented will be published, as they have been sent. It is essential to review personal information and texts before sending.

Calendar

Deadline for receipt of communication proposals attached to the sessions: September 30, 2023.

Notification of acceptance of communication proposals by the coordination of the thematic sessions: October 15, 2023.

Proposal submission procedure

First of all, you must choose the thematic session to which you wish to join, consulting the different sessions on our website.

The communication proposal will be sent to the email address gr.gremher@ub.edu, with the requested data. Please indicate in the subject of the message "II GREMHER Symposium", followed by the title of the affiliation session.

The people in charge of coordinating each session will receive the communication proposals, select them and organize them for their exhibition. Each session may collect up to a maximum of eight contributions and will require a minimum of four for their inclusion in the final program.
