Language of courses	Our bachelor lectures are delivered mainly in Catalan and Spanish. Lectures of the Reservoir Geology and Geophysics Master degree (RGG) are delivered in English. Lectures of the Mineral Resources and Geological Hazards (MRGH) are mainly taught in Spanish.
Language requirements	We do not require exchange students to pass a language test. We do however expect exchange students who will follow courses to be able to follow the lectures. Therefore we strongly suggest all incoming students to prepare their knowledge of Spanish or Catalan thoroughly before coming to Barcelona. In the Bachelor Degree, the exams are generally in Catalan or Spanish and there is no guarantee that the professor will offer the option of taking it in English. In the case of Master Degrees, the exams will be kept in English (RGG) and Spanish (MRGH)

Choice of courses	<p>Students are asked to choose courses from the Faculty of Geology (from different degrees) but they can also take courses from faculties other than Geology, but they cannot exceed 49% of the total. In this case, they will need to request permission to the person in charge of international exchanges of the faculty that offers the course they are interested in.</p> <p>The access to master courses requires the approval of the Master programme's director.</p> <p>Students can also perform an internship in a laboratory, but they have to contact the relevant coordinator and register it. There are two options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Half time lab training: 15 ECTS - Full time lab training: 30 ECTS
