The first Multiplier Event of the **Project Digital Education for Crisis Situations: Times in which there is no alternative (DECriS)** (<https://decris.ffos.hr/>) will take place on November 4 and 5, 2021, in a **hybrid mode** (via Zoom and face-to-face) at the Faculty of Information and Media, University of Barcelona.
