



**Call for papers: *International Conference on Managing Corruption Risks in Urban Planning: Towards a Model of Public Compliance***

The *International Conference on Corruption Risk Management in Urban Planning: Towards a Model of Public Compliance* will be held on Thursday 17 October 2019 at the University of Barcelona.

This conference seeks to foster the development of knowledge and academic reflection on the prevention of corruption in urban planning through techniques associated with compliance programs that have spread in the private sector, including, among others, risk management, internal reporting channels and codes of ethics and conduct.

The Director of the event invites those interested in this topic to submit papers at the conference. In this case, the written text of the communication must be sent to the Director at the e-mail address [ocapdeferro@ub.edu](mailto:ocapdeferro@ub.edu), before 1 October 2019. On 2 October 2019, the authors of the communications submitted will be informed of the acceptance or rejection of their communication and the final program will be published with the accepted communications and papers.

The selected proposals will be publicly defended at the Conference and may be published by a prestigious specialized publishing house in Spain, in a collective book with the results of the Conference.

The following are topics of interest at this conference:

- Transparency in urban planning
- Integrity in planning
- Corruption risk management in planning, especially at the local level
- Local codes of ethics and codes of conduct
- Compliance programs and their application in urban planning
- Analysis of corruption cases in planning
- The identification of risk factors for corruption and malpractice in planning and urban development

Scientific texts presented as a communication should be 15-25 pages long, including notes, graphs, tables and bibliography. Bibliographic citations in the main text or footnote should be in Harvard style. Bibliography cited in the body of the text should be included in a final section as a list of bibliographic references.
