Call for papers

We are excited to announce a call for papers for a Workshop in Development Economics, to be held at the **University of Barcelona on October 19th and 20th, 2023**. The workshop will offer a forum to share and receive constructive feedback on work-in-progress, and to support the establishment of a community of researchers linked (through current or previous affiliations) to Spanish universities or research centres that work in all fields of development economics. Our goal is to foster long-term collaborations and increase the visibility of development economics research conducted across these institutions.

The workshop theme for this year will be ‘Children, Gender, and Policies in Low- and Middle-Income Countries’, but submissions focused on topics more broadly related to social and economic development in low- and middle-countries settings are also welcome. We are honoured to host Prof. Karen Macours (Paris School of Economics), who will deliver a keynote.

The deadline for paper submissions is 23 July 2023. Full papers will be prioritised.

Please submit your full paper or extended abstract in pdf format to devecon.workshop.ub@gmail.com. Accepted papers will be notified by the end of August at latest.

There will be no registration fee. However, accommodation and travelling costs should be covered by participants. An informal dinner will be organized on October 19th with workshop participants.
