

I, Conxa Planas, Secretary of the University of Barcelona Language Policy Committee,

DO CERTIFY: that at the regular meeting held on 24 October, the Language Policy Committee approved the following language requirements for computer applications


1. Computer applications (websites, institutional management applications, e-learning interfaces, computer-assisted class projects, etc.) must be implemented in Catalan.
2. These computer applications may also be implemented in other languages, depending on the specific language needs of the knowledge area to which they belong or in accordance with the expected dissemination, distribution and marketing.
3. The UB's computer applications must always start in Catalan.
4. For computer applications available in more than one language, the fact that priority shall be given to initial use in Catalan shall not preclude users from being able to choose the language in which they wish to interact with the interface when setting up their work session.
5. Operating systems and computer applications not developed by the University of Barcelona (commercial or open-source) must be installed at UB facilities (offices, departments, libraries, computer rooms, etc.) in Catalan whenever a Catalan version is available and there are no technical requirements that would make such a setup unadvisable or impossible.
